THE VISIONARY
Rene Gonzalez

Renowned Miami architect Rene Gonzalez designed a home in Indian Creek (the famously wealthy half-square-mile island neighborhood between Miami and North Miami Beach where CEOs reside next to pop stars) that's highly site-specific—stone-wall pavilions deliver prescribed shadows and light patterns, outdoor water pools mimic the drama of the surrounding ocean and green lawns utilize environmentally conscious peanut grass. The three-year effort paid off: In August 2012, the two-acre mansion sold for \$47 million to a mystery Russian buyer and became the most expensive house ever purchased in Miami-Dade County. rengonzalezarchitect.com.
